WHERE WE ARE

- 85% of participants were employed over the past year
- 839 hours were worked during our summer session
- Job matching is utilized as participants are pre-screened to ensure a good match between employer and employee
- Every participant has OHS and WHMIS testing













FAQ

Q: Who pays the participants' wages?

A: The employer is responsible for paying the participants' wages, however Job Coaches are paid for and employed by Reena. This gives the employer the advantage of two qualified employees for the price of one.

Q: Are workers with disabilities more likely to have accidents?

A: No. A Dupont study showed that in terms of safety, 97% of workers with disabilities rate average or above average. It is our belief that anyone given the proper training can work safely.

Q: How many hours is a student able to work?

A: This is dependent on the participant's abilities. In the past, participants have worked a range of hours ranging from 3 to 20 per week. It is preferable for the participants to have set weekly hours. This is helpful for scheduling Job Coaches and participant transportation.



Q: Who is responsible for both the participant's and the Job Coach's WSIB?

A: As with any other employee, the participant employed is covered by the employer's WISB, whereas the Job Coach is covered by Reena.

Q: What if the participant does not work out?

A: This situation does not normally happen as ongoing supports are offered to both the participant and the employer. However, if the hired participant does not work out, the employer's general recourse will be enacted.
